
4. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND COMMENTS

Intangible benefits are recouped from the supply of burn material for extensive fire-fighting training operations once a month. In addition, by not burying wood at the Landfill, the life of the Sanitary Landfill will be extended two years or more.

The recoupment of pallets will save for a tangible benefit of \$2,444.62 per month; for a yearly savings of \$29,335.40.

CURRENT PROCEDURE

Scrap wood is presently be stored at the Base Landfill and sold by DPDO. The Contractor sorts and takes only the best wood, leaving tons of undesirable wood. New state regulations prevents the burning of anything in the Landfill area, thereby leaving the unwanted wood to be moved by Base Maintenance or buried in the landfill.

PROPOSED PROCEDURE (If a directive/order must be waived to implement proposal-Identify the specific reference.)

All scrap wood should be taken to DPDO, Lot 203. There is additional space available on the back side of the lot. At this location, when the unwanted wood becomes large enough to burn, Base Maintenance will send a bulldozer to prepare the burn site. The Base Fire Department can use this for fire training exercises.

BENEFITS/ADVANTAGES

1. DPDO can salvage all useable pallets.
2. Close inspection can prevent any hazardous waste from entering site.
3. Scales are available to weigh lumber sold.
4. Prevent the relocating of unwanted wood from the landfill to another site.
5. Provide fire training.




