Install Bypass Line On Receiver

Describe in three separate paragraphs (1) the problem, difficulty, or circumstances that prompted you to submit this suggestion; (2) the suggested change; where and how it can be used, what it will accomplish, and how it will benefit the Navy/Government - in terms of tangible savings, if possible.

The Below Listed Buildings were originally designed for Heat and Cool operation Year round. Units for this type of operation need a large receiver. (place to store Refrigerant not being used) For cold weather operation. The units in the listed buildings are no longer used during winter operations, but in their present configuration they have to be charged with refrigerant as they would be used in winter operation. This is approximately 180 lbs. of refrigerant more than would be required for summer operation without using a receiver. Any time the system develops a leak in the Refrigerant System when components of the system are replaced 180 lbs. of unnecessary refrigerant is lost. Refrigerant Components that are replaced include expansion valves, pinoid valves, Hand and service valves, and Compressors. 180 lbs. of refrigerant @ 1.30 per lb. is a loss of \$234.00 Dollars each time a component is replaced.

By installing a bypass line on the receiver the receiver could be bypassed and the Refrigerant needed to fill the receiver (Approximately 180 lb.) for summer operation would not be required. In addition the receiver would remain full the system should it ever be needed for winter operation. The bypass line can be installed using only 2 in. copper tees, 1 in. hand valve and two short lengths of copper tubing, The modification would cost approximately \$220.40 less depending on the receiver size.


This modification can be used at any Installation and on any system with receiver that is not used for winter operation. It will eliminate the need to fill the receiver with Refrigerant. It will save \$234.00 each time the unit is discharged to repair a leak or replace a component. At present the listed buildings are discharged and repaired at present once a year. The modification would save at a minimum of \$702.00 the first year.
