



-GSA alkyd paint is not odorless (it says so on the can), it is so strong that the tenants can hardly stay in the quarters when the painters are painting as it irritates the eyes and nose.  
-It takes longer to do the job using GSA alkyd paint because of the applicability, cleaning equipment, etc.

- In the winter months, alkyd paint gets thick and stiff and you can't utilize it until it warms up.
- It takes paint thinner to thin, which adds to the cost (approximately 1 pint per gal). It also takes a solvent to clean the equipment.
- It takes a longer period of time to box and thin than it does with latex.
- Should be able to obtain a less expensive price from the contractor using latex paint.
- Latex paint is used on all newly-constructed houses.
- There are no hazards involved using latex paint.
- Latex paint cleans up easily with water.
- This is a GSA stocked paint. Housing issues for self-help program.







PAINT SUBSTITUTION

I suggest that: The Interior Alkyd Flat Paint, White, # 37778 (FSN 8010-00-180-6241-GL/8010-00-180-6240-CN/5GL) for painting interior walls and ceilings of government quarters at prescribed intervals, occupant damage on check-out and touch up prior to assignment/ check-in, currently used by the Family Housing Division (Issued in Self-Help), Base Maintenance and Civilian Paint Contractor be substituted. Substitution paint, Interior Latex Flat, White, # 37875 (FSN 8010-00-598-5733-GL/8010-00-598-5730-CN/5GL). This paint can be used in all government quarters for painting interior walls and ceilings. Interior Latex Flat, # 37875 is synthetic, ready-mixed and can be sprayed or brushed on, it dries smooth in one (1) hour, has excellent hiding qualities, painted areas may be used the same day, wash with soap and water, retains color after repeated washings. One gallon covers up to 400 square feet and surfaces need not be primed. Brushes and equipment can be cleaned with soapy water. Contains NO FLAMMABLE SUBSTANCES. GSA Specification # TT-P-29. Interior Alkyd Flat, # 37778 is odorless, one gallon covers 450


INTERIOR LATEX FLAT # 37875 cost \$5.20 per gallon / \$24.00 per five (5) gallon can.

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




