1. Request that future notification of asbestos removal projects be prepared by PWO and BMO per the instructions at enclosure (1). The single State point of contact for these notices is Mr. Wakild in Wilmington. The format for these notices should conform to enclosure (2). Further, request that future notices to the State by contractors be discontinued because the obligation to notify and track these projects resides with the Commanding General, Marine Corps Base.

2. Copies of the "notice" form will be provided to the Base Safety Office and the Naval Hospital, Attn: Head, O&PMD. For assistance in identification of asbestos to include sample collection and analyses, contact the Base Industrial Hygienist, ext 5707. For assistance in asbestos project inspections and surveys, contact the Base Safety Office, ext 5725. The confirmed starting date for demolition/renovation should be announced to these offices as far in advance as possible.
