






Subj: The Secretary of Defense Natural Resources
Conservation Award for 1977

1. The Secretary of Defense has announced, in conjunction with the subject award, the citation of the Marine Corps Base (MCB), Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, for sustained excellence in the management of soil and water, fish and wildlife, and forestry resources.
2. This is the fourth time in the past six years that the MCB, Camp Lejeune has been recognized by the Secretary of Defense for accomplishments in the field of natural resources management. Most significant among the many accomplishments of base personnel during the 1975-1977 award evaluation period are:
 - a. Establishment of a 2,300 acre area devoted principally to the intensive management of the bobwhite quail.
 - b. Initiation of experimental wildlife plantings of *lespedeza thunbergii*.
 - c. Cooperative turkey stocking program to assist the state in establishing the wild turkey on state lands.
 - d. Initiation of wildlife research projects in cooperation with North Carolina State University.
 - e. Initiation of a survey of archaeological and cultural resources.
 - f. Award of timber sales valued at \$1,263,940.
 - g. Continued protection of the habitat of endangered species of wildlife.
3. Information regarding plans for the presentation of appropriate awards will be provided by this Headquarters when announced by the office of the Secretary of Defense.


