Dear Sir:

This is to advise your agency that Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune plans to improve an existing boat ramp on Base property located on the north-west side of Sneads Ferry Bridge which spans New River, Onslow County, North Carolina. The enclosed permit application which was received from the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers depicts the proposed structure.

It should be noted that some excavation below the mean high water in an area where no marsh grass is established will be necessary. Also masonry rubble will be placed below the mean high water to protect the ramp from high tides and wave action.

It has been determined to the best of my knowledge that the proposed project is in compliance with the State of North Carolina approved coastal management program and will be conducted in a manner consistent with same.
