Encl: (1) Scope of Work for Camp Lejeune Railroad

1. The reference advised that Norfolk/Southern has provided maintenance on certain signals at six crossings since 5 September 1984, but due to the Railroad Company not being compensated for the maintenance, as of 1 October 1987 Norfolk/Southern has advised that all work will cease on the signals and maintenance will become the responsibility of the Government.

The six affected crossings are listed as follows:

<u>Road</u>	<u>Mile Post</u>
1. Sneads Ferry Road	CL 0.00
2. Route 24	CL 3.15
3. SR-1413	CL 3.70
4. Belgrade Road	CL 12.60
5. Route 58	CL 16.20
6. Lake Road	CL 26.90

2. Currently this Command is working with an Architectural/Engineering firm to develop a Service Contract with a scope as shown by enclosure (1) and until that Service Contract is made available the Base Maintenance Division has advised that all signals and trackage will be maintained by Base Maintenance Personnel.

3. It is requested that Norfolk/Southern be notified that as of 1 October 1987 the maintenance of the trackage and signals will be provided through this Command and also it is requested that Norfolk/Southern be notified that if any malfunctions do develop to the various crossings, signals or trackage during their use of the Railroad that Base Maintenance Personnel be advised by calling (919)451-5794/5796 and request to speak with Mr. Mike Strain or Mr. Jim Grimmett, but if problems develop after hours call (919)451-3001.
