Dear Sir:

This has reference to buried cable which was placed by the Telephone Company on Government property located at the intersection of Queens Creek Road and Highway #172. The attached drawings show pertinent details as to the location.

An encroachment agreement with a map marked to show the proposed cable route from Swansboro was submitted to the North Carolina Highway Department and was subsequently approved. This project involved burying a small telephone cable in the shoulder of the highway 3 feet from the edge of the pavement and 18 to 24 inches deep. The above method of placing communications cable is an accepted practice along highways in North Carolina. The fact that a small segment of this project was on the Camp LeJeune Reservation was overlooked by us, and evidently by the Highway Department as well.

Our construction forces completed the placing of the cable on October 28, 1959, and we were notified by the Marine Corps on November 2, 1959, that we were on Government property.


This work was required in order to serve six applicants for telephone service along Highway #172 just off the Reservation. Service to these applicants (who, incidentally, are service personnel) is being held up until it is determined whether or not we will be allowed to leave the cable in its present location.

It is, therefore, requested that permission be granted this Company to leave its cable in place as shown on the attached drawing with the understanding that other arrangements will be made by this Company in event such cable interferes with future operations at Camp LeJeune.



A letter agreement or other appropriate instrument authorizing this encroachment on the Camp LeJeune Reservation will be greatly appreciated.


BEAR CREEK IS RESERVATION BOUNDARY



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
RESERVATION BOUNDARY


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
