CURRENT PROCEDURE

Waste oil and petroleum products are stored at units in containers in sizes from five gallons to 500 gallons with no specific location.

PROPOSED PROCEDURE (If a directive/order must be waived to implement proposal-Identify the specific reference.)

That Base request information from units which generate waste oil/fuel and install containers in 500 and 1,000 gallon sizes which are color coded.

BENEFITS/ADVANTAGES

1. A schedule could be prepared and the products picked up on a schedule.
2. Seperation of oil from fuel, and product could be sold, rather than paying to have it disposed of.
3. Reduce equipment and labor cost to pick-up small quantities.
4. Re-utilize inefficient labor into other areas.
