Calendar Year 1987

1. Target Pest Water Lilies (Spatter Docks, Cow Lily)
2. Purpose of Control for the effective control of aquatic weed problems, infesting fresh water ponds which are managed for recreational fishing
3. Pesticide selected for use:
 - a. Name of pesticide Aquathol Plus
 - b. Percent active ingredient of lbs. per gal. 1.8
 - c. Registration number USDA 4581-183
4. Application:
 - a. Form of pesticide to be applied Dipotassium salt of endothall
 - b. Final strength of formulation 2 ppm - per acre
 - c. Application rate and method 1.0 gallon per acre
 - d. Area to be treated (acres) (sq ft) 3 acres (209' x 209' each)
 - e. Location of treatment area Ward, Cedar Point and Powerline
 - f. Number and period of applications 1 May - 1987
 - g. Equipment required Portable sprayer mounted in 14' boat
5. Environmental and health safety:
 - a. Areas to be avoided Shoreline areas of ponds
 - b. Areas to be treated with caution All areas where water lilies not present
 - c. Precautions Eye, breath protectors and disposable coveralls will be utilized by applicator
6. Operations:
 - a. Applicator Willie Gray Bastic, Fish & Wildlife Technician
 - b. Monitoring of application performed by others and effectiveness of treatment Albert C. Henry, Jr.



These facilities were constructed with a earthern dam designed with water control structure including a riser, gate and drain pipe and their locations are also listed below.
