Thank you for considering us in the revision process for the Environmental Permit Directory. This Directory has been of great value to our environmental staff as well as, Headquarters, Marine Corps and the Naval Facilities Engineering Command. We have used this Directory daily to inform planners, consultant engineers and other Marine Corps officials regarding North Carolina environmental processes.

One of the most important environmental issues facing Camp Lejeune is the difficulty in keeping a current set of environmental policies upon which to make decisions. As you know, this issue affects numerous federal agencies as well as the private sector. We have subscribed to the North Carolina Register; however, none of the publications have been received yet. Any effort which you could make toward consolidating and distributing the latest environmental policies is greatly appreciated.

We note the requirements of the North Carolina Department of Cultural Resources are not included in the Directory for protection of historic resources. These rules seem to change less frequently than other permit-type rules but are a significant consideration in our land management and siting decisions. It would assist us in using the Directory if they were included.

We again request approximately 50 copies of the 1987 Environmental Directory if you have them to spare. Thank you for your continued assistance in this matter.
