1. I have reviewed the proposed correspondence, transmitted by reference (a), and it my opinion that it is deficient in several respects.

2. First, the proposed correspondence is too mild. It simply does not communicate the significance and seriousness which surrounds a violation of reference (b). For instance, reference (b) states that the Director, Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) can assess civil penalties ranging from \$500 to \$5,000 per violation; and this is in addition to criminal sanctions which could be imposed in the same matter including felony penalties with \$10,000 per day fines plus imprisonment. Under the law, each spill, however slight, is a separate violation. It is not as if our violations will never be noted: The law requires us to report each violation to Region IV, EPA in Atlanta, and we dutifully comply.

3. Second, the only investigation conducted in this case was an on-site survey. A more complete investigation may have indicated the specific individuals changing oil on the day of the spill, the instructions received by the younger Marines concerning oil recycling, and the location of the military supervisors at the time 75 gallons of used oil from a grease rack were dumped into a drainage ditch instead of the oil recycling tank that was installed 20 yards or so from that same grease rack. This particular case appears to indicate a serious lack of supervision and environmental concern on the part of the individuals involved.

4. Under the terms of reference (c), Marine Corps Base has the responsibility to execute the environmental protection plan for MCAS (H), New River, including a program which provides for a system of collection and disposal of waste petroleum products. Paragraphs 5 and 6 of reference (c) indicate that COMCABEST should be coordinated with where command action is necessary to enforce the environmental protection plan. References (d) and (e) comprise the plan.

1. As requested by reference (a), an investigation has been initiated to inquire into the circumstances surrounding the oil spill which occurred near Cogdel's Creek on 23 July 1979.
2. The seriousness of this accident is well recognized and increased effort has been made to preclude similar incidents. Storage of petroleum products in 220,000 gallon collapsible fuel tanks has been discontinued until serviceable replacements can be obtained.
3. The Commanding Officer, 8th Engineer Support Battalion has provided a team of Marines to the Base Maintenance Department, Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs Division to assist in a clean up of the oil spill. Accordingly, this force will remain at your disposal until the clean up operation is complete. It has been noted during the course of clean up that unidentified units have used the area around Cogdel's Creek as a dumping ground for oil drums and other miscellaneous trash.
4. Future incidents involving spillage of fuel will be reported in accordance with reference (b).
