Subj: Oil Pollution

1. On 28 January 1976 a representative from Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs Division, Base Maintenance Department visited Motor Transport Maintenance Company, Building 1601 (steam cleaning area) to investigate an oil spill problem which had been reported by Emergency Maintenance personnel. Upon investigation it was discovered that oil, transmission grease, oily rags, etc. were being dumped on the deck and into a floor drain inside the building. The oil was flowing to an underground drainage system and eventually to New River. This situation violates pollution abatement guidelines contained in references (a) and (b).

2. On 2 and 6 February 1976 Emergency Maintenance personnel were called back to Building 1601 to clean the floor drain of oil, grease and rags. These series of events indicate a recurring problem which is in need of correction. Further the Base Fire Department advised Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs Division that the same area of Building 1601 was documented as a fire hazard in 1975. It is requested that immediate and increased efforts be devoted to correction of this problem.
