

1. This Command desires to develop the area east of Camp Geiger (Brinson Creek Area) into a recreation site for the Camp Geiger Marines, and their Dependents. This area will have swings for the children, a section for swimming, fishing and an area for grills and picnic tables. This Command requests assistance for completing this project, as depicted by the following enclosures.

a. Enclosure (1) contains photos of the shore line to be cleared and restored.

b. Enclosure (2) contains a photo of the proposed area for the beach. The beach area must be graded and sand dumped and spread evenly.

c. Enclosure (3) contains a photo of the proposed area for a five foot jetty running perpendicular from the left side of the platform.

d. Enclosure (4) contains photos of the proposed picnic area graded back to the tree line and then seeded.


e. Enclosure (5) contains photos depicting depressions under trees that need to be filled and then seeded. It is also requested that two head facilities be constructed in this area for males and females.

f. Enclosure (6) contains photos of the proposed parking area which must be graded and spread with shell rock.

a. Justification: Camp Geiger is in need of a recreational area were Marines without transportation/limited funds frequent on weekends and holidays. Furthermore, Camp Geiger does not possess a swimming pool. This area could be used by units for water survival training.






