2. It is noted that a 1977 Solid Waste Study by SCS Engineers at Marine Corps Base indicated 133 tons/day of waste over a five day period was being generated.

1. During reference (a) it was learned that Larimer Corps Base was in a state of noncompliance with EPA solid waste disposal regulations. A number of violations were identified. It is requested that you advise the base legal situation.

2. It is noted that in 1977 Solid Waste Study by SCS Engineers at Larimer Corps Base indicated that tonnage of waste over a five-day period was being generated.
