
1. Recent inspections in all housing areas indicate numerous oil spills involving subject contractor which were not reported or cleaned up as required by references (a) and (b). Enclosure (1) depicts some of the oil spill situations.

2. It is requested that a complete inspection be conducted in the housing areas to identify oil spill situations caused by the contractor and that a job order number be established authorizing Base Maintenance Department to remove oil contaminated soil and restore the areas.

3. Further, it is requested that an increased effort be devoted toward elimination of oil spills in the housing area by requiring the home heating oil delivery contractor to comply with references (a) and (b). Mr. Julian Wooten of this Department, extensions 5003/2083, is the point of contact in this matter.



Mr. Yates stated that he would check into the matter; however, as of this writing no further word has been received. You are reminded that spills must be reported as set forth in paragraph J-6 of the contract to avoid further penalty.
