1. During a recent visit to Marine Corps Base by the Army Corps of Engineers personnel to inspect a proposed boat ramp construction site, it was learned that a possible violation of the Clean Water Act was occurring due to soil eroding to wetland areas aboard base. The Army Corps of Engineers enforcement personnel have contacted Base Maintenance Department personnel twice about inspecting the erosion site and discussing the situation if it is determined that a violation exists. Another call from the Corps of Engineers is expected Thursday morning, 1 March 1979, to arrange an inspection.
2. It is requested that research on the Clean Water Act be conducted to determine if the Corps of Engineers has enforcement responsibility at Marine Corps Base, as discussed during reference (a).
