1. During reference (a) it was concluded that subject facility addressed in reference (b) could be used in conformance with reference (c). However, it is recommended that the existing waste oil storage tank be equipped with a rainproof funnel. Base Maintenance Department can, upon request, install the funnel. Also, a platform (with steps) should be built to facilitate the pouring of oil into the tank.

2. Further, it is recommended that oil contaminated soil be replaced with clean topsoil and seeded.


