1. As a result of recent fuel spills, the Environmental Protection Agency and the United States Coast Guard have expressed concern about the practice of storing petroleum products in fuel bladders. Representatives recently visited Marine Corps Base to discuss the large number of spills occurring at this activity and the deep concern of all interested agencies.
2. By reference (a) the Commandant of the Marine Corps inquired about the increase of oil spills at Camp Lejeune and actions taken to reduce oil spill events. This inquiry was prompted by the Secretary of Defense.
3. Considering the expressed concern associated with oil spills and potential legal implications, it is recommended that the request contained in reference (b) be reevaluated. If it is determined that the storage of petroleum is absolutely necessary for mission essential requirements, permission to do so is granted. A program of education and proper procedures to safeguard the potential of another spill must be emphasized.


