



PERSONAL CAPITAL PLANT EQUIPMENT (INVESTMENT-TYPE ITEMS) WITH A UNIT  
COST OF \$1,000 OR MORE

1. Prepare separate Detail Lists (enclosure (1) for Fiscal Year 1981 and Fiscal Year 1982. Detailed Lists shall be broken down into functional groups. Each item on the detailed list will be supported by brief justification, e.g., age, condition, excessive maintenance costs, parts problems, replacement versus repair, modernization, new requirement implications, increases in personnel, table of organization, training, condition code or age alone is not sufficient and should be supported by economic aspects. This justification should also reflect the primary utilization of the equipment and in which organization (function) it is used. Items required for Equipment Installation or Urgent Minor Construction Projects should be indicated. Refer to enclosure (3) for determination of major items within functional groups of the detailed list.
2. Do not include food preparation and serving equipment unless identified in paragraph 2b of basic letter. All food preparation and serving equipment used exclusively for training purposes will be funded by Marine Corps Service Support Schools.
3. Do not include construction, railway and weight handling equipment. These are budgeted for by Headquarters, Marine Corps.
4. Do not include items submitted under separate programs, i.e., Garrison Mobile Engineer Equipment (reference MCO 11260.3), Nonstandard Photographic Equipment (reference MCO P3150.3), Training Support Center Equipment (reference MCO 1551.1), Special Service Equipment (reference MCO P1710.17), T/E items (reference NAVMC 1019), Stationary items of construction or weight handling equipment or other Garrison Mobile Equipment which do not fall within the scope of the Garrison Mobile Equipment Procurement Program should be included.
5. Those plant equipment items with a unit cost of \$1,000 or more, not submitted in separate programs, will be included.
6. Do not include the value of this report within the Expense Operating Budget.
7. Equipment installation will be funded as a part of the procurement cost when a single contractor is providing for the equipment and installation in a single contract.



CATEGORIES OF PERSONAL CAPITAL PLANT EQUIPMENT BASED ON FUNCTIONAL USE

Functional Groups

Major Items Within Groups

Class 3 Equipment

Buildings and Grounds  
Maintenance Equipment

Cranes (stationary), floor sanders, floor scrubbers, vacuum cleaners, and waste compactors. Attachments or auxiliary equipment to end items, such as mowers, plows, road sweepers, and sprayers (refer to paragraph 5050.7b of reference).

Office Equipment

Accounting and calculating machines, addressing machines, bookbinding equipment, cash registers, dictating and transcribing machines, duplicating equipment, mailing machines, microfilm equipment, printing equipment, safes, time recorders, typewriters, and visible record equipment.

Medical and Dental  
Equipment

Audiometers, dental chairs, diathermy, incubators, lamps, medical cabinets, microscopes, operating tables, ophthalmometers, resuscitators, sterilizers, whirlpools, and x-ray machines.

Utilities Equipment  
(Stationary)

Battery chargers, compressors, engine generators, fire extinguishers, intercoms, public address systems, radar speed equipment, radio sets, rectifiers, telecopiers, telephone equipment, and teletypewriters.

General Purpose  
Equipment

Boats, bonding machines, conveyors, hand trucks, hoists, musical instruments, packaging and wrapping machinery, safety equipment, security equipment, sound modules, standard photographic equipment not furnished under MCO P3150.3 and training equipment not furnished under MCO 1551.1. In addition, the following food service equipment; dishwashers, drinking water coolers, waste disposers (such as incinerators), hoods and vents.
