



**Subj:** REQUEST FOR POLLUTION ABATEMENT SURVEY

1. Marine Air Traffic Control Squadron 28, located in Building CG-1, has 24 trailer-mounted generators, two of which are located at their airfield operations site and 14 at Bogue Field. After each 40 hours of operation (approximately weekly), the generators are rotated back to CG-1 for cleaning and preventive maintenance. They are placed on an asphalt surface and cleaned with a surface cleaner/disinfectant and a portable steam unit. The soap, water, dirt and grease from the equipment runs off the asphalt and onto the surrounding ground. Normally 3 or 4 generators or towing vehicles are cleaned per week day.

2. It is requested that an oil pollution abatement survey of this operation be conducted to determine if a need exists for a sanitary sewer connection for discharging wastewater. Point of contact at the Command is Mary Wheat, extensions 6518/6686.
