


Subj: STONEBAY REHAB PROJECT



1. Enclosure (1) includes a list of materials required to repair or alter the existing facilities into a viable, austere training, MAU (SOC), facility. Much of the doors, hardware, or furnishings inside the buildings can be used or second hand from DPRO. Also specifically not included was the steel required for the shooting house. This can be provided by SOTG thru DPRO and delivered to the site.


2. The capability exists within SOTG to construct all wood frame internal walls, hang doors and windows, repair masonry, and construct security cages. We do not have the capability to do any earth landscaping, welding for shooting houses, electrical power connections, or establishment of water points and head facilities around various buildings.

3. Priorities for construction are as follows:

1. Shooting house, bldg. 201
2. Cadre, *COC, Comm* bldg. 203
3. Wax, BB shooting houses, bldg. 211, 213, 215
4. Conf./classroom spaces for troops, bldg. 204
5. Supply/storage spaces, bldg. 206
6. Shooting Range, bldg. 202

Note: Power to the local area is required to start framing internal walls.

4. POC at II MAF, SOTG is Capt VIK and Capt BARTH.
