1. It is requested that the following modifications be made to the subject contract:

a. Parcel 16 should be made rectangular in shape as depicted in enclosure (1). Page J-7 of the contract states that Parcel 16 includes AS-820, 822 and 843. However, the map only includes AS-820.

b. Parcel 14 should include the main BOQ building and surrounding area as shown in enclosure (1). At the present time, the BOQ is included with Parcel 34. Our VIP Quarters are located in this building.

c. Parcel 34 should be expanded to include grass areas not shown on the contract map. See enclosure (1) for the additional area.

d. The Fuel Farm and surrounding area should be included in Parcel 55. See enclosure (1).

e. Parcel 53 should be expanded to include all grass areas on both sides of Wilson Street. See enclosure (1).

f. Parcel 57A should be expanded so that grass is cut to treeline. See enclosure (1).

g. Parcel 62 should be expanded to include both sides of Perimeter Road. See enclosure (1) for specific grass areas requiring inclusion.

h. Parcel 66 should be expanded to include all common grass areas noted in enclosure (1). These areas must be kept mowed to prevent snakes and other pests from being attracted to the Family Housing area.

i. Parcel 64 should include the vacant areas depicted on enclosure (1).

j. A new Level III Parcel should be made to include the Rapid Refuel area and the grass within 15 feet of hard-stand areas and around the runway/taxiway lights. This area must be kept mowed/trimmed for safety reasons well in excess of the number of times the remaining Parcel 62 requires cutting. The use of herbicide around taxiway lights is encouraged to prevent damage during trimming operations.


