

OPERATIONS ON THE ATLANTIC INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY (AIWW)  
Ref: (a) EODO ltr 8027 over EOD dtd 24 Mar 87(NOTAL)

1. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has identified a requirement for a 12 week period to perform EOD clearance and dredging operations on the AIWW.
2. The section of the AIWW in front of ranges G-5, 6, and 7 is the area effected. A review of scheduled and projected training was conducted and the period 14 September 1987 through 6 December 1987 was selected to perform the necessary work.
3. Accordingly, ranges G-5, 6, and 7 will be shut down during 14 September 1987 through 6 December 1987. This information should be considered when scheduling training during that period.





Subj: EXPLOSIVE ORDNANCE DISPOSAL CLEARANCE AND DREDGING ON THE  
ATLANTIC INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY

1. The following information is provided for planning purposes, and it is subject to change as coordination meetings take place.
2. I was requested by Mr. Berry Holiday of the Corps of Engineers to recommend a (12) week time frame in which EOD clearance and dredging operations could be conducted in that section of the Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway which runs in front of ranges G-5, 6 and 7. A review of scheduled and projected training was done and the period of 14 September 1987 through 6 December 1987 was selected.
3. As of 870320 that section of the Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway in front of ranges G-5, 6, and 7 is scheduled for EOD clearance and dredging operations from 14 September 1987 through 6 December 1987.
4. Mr. Berry Holiday and a representative from U.S. Navy EOD Group 2 were notified on 870320.
5. The COE will officially task the Navy for EOD support and a coordination meeting will be scheduled.
6. It is my hope that the aforementioned time frames can be shortened by simultaneously dredging and clearing in certain parts of the waterway or scheduling clearance/dredging operations in a way to allow the opening of one of the G-5, 6 and 7 ranges during this time.

Subj: REQUEST FOR SPECIAL SERVICES CABANAS

1. During March 1987, the Wilmington, N.C., District Army Corps of Engineers plan to dredge the Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway (AIWW), passing through live firing ranges G-5 and G-6 aboard Camp Lejeune. This necessitates the removal/destruction of dud ordnance in the AIWW. Navy Explosive Ordnance Disposal Group Two, Fort Story, Virginia, is sending a team of divers TAD to Camp Lejeune for a period of approximately three weeks to clean the AIWW of dud ordnance. The dates for the operation are scheduled 28 February through 15 March 1987.

2. It is requested that berthing for the Navy divers be authorized in the Special Services cabanas located at the northern end of Onslow Beach. This location is most desirable as it is very convenient to the site of operation and messing could be accomplished by the individual. Due to the working hours of the EOD team, messing in messhalls is impractical.

3. It is requested that one cabana for officers and eight for enlisted personnel be made available 28 February through 15 March 1987.
