Subj: Fire-fighting Details

Ref: (a) BO 11320.1G

1. Purpose. To publish information and guidance pertaining to fire-fighting details from the 2d Marine Division.

2. Cancellation. DivO 11320.1A.

3. Information. The reference tasks the 2d Marine Division with maintaining two 20 man fire-fighting details. These details, along with those of the other major commands, are to be on call at all times to assist the Base Fire Department in extinguishing fires in the Camp Lejeune area. Additionally, these details may be called upon to aid other governmental agencies outside the confines of the federal reservation.

4. Concept

a. Assignment of 2d Marine Division organizations to fire-fighting details shall be accomplished by separate bulletin.

b. During normal working hours details shall be requested through the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-4. After normal hours and on weekends and holidays, details shall be requested through the Command Duty Officer.

c. Fire-fighting details will consist of 20 Marines each. No less than four of the 20 Marines will be noncommissioned officers.

d. Upon notification by this Headquarters of Fire Danger Class ~~III~~ <sup>IV</sup> or higher, fire-fighting details will be placed in a standby status and be prepared to depart for the scene of the fire within thirty minutes. To facilitate coordination with the Base Fire Department, an assembly area will be designated by the unit commander or duty officer and the location reported to this Headquarters.

e. Fire-fighting details will be provided specialized equipment by the Base Fire Department. Details will report to the scene of the fire wearing the utility uniform with appropriate seasonal outer wear and, as a minimum, a cartridge belt, two canteens (filled) with covers, one canteen cup, and one first-aid kit per individual.

f. Parent units of fire-fighting details will be prepared to support each detail with food and drinking water at the fire scene.

g. When feasible, transportation to the fire scene will be provided from the heavy-lift assets of the unit providing the fire detail. Vehicle support for infantry units will be provided from Truck Company, Headquarters Battalion. Support shall consist of one truck (2 1/2 tons or larger) and one M105 trailer per detail. Vehicles will remain with the fire-fighting details for the duration of employment.


5. Action

a. Assistant Chief of Staff, G-4. Publish a semi-annual bulletin assigning responsibilities for fire-fighting details.

b. Commanding Officers, 2d Marines, 6th Marines, 10th Marines, Headquarters Battalion, Combat Engineer Battalion, Tank Battalion and 2d Light Armored Vehicle Battalion. Upon notification, be prepared to provide fire-fighting details in accordance with the reference and paragraph 4 above.

c. Commanding Officer, 8th Marines. As the Camp Geiger Area Commander, be prepared to provide one 20 man fire-fighting detail in accordance with the reference.

d. Commanding Officer, 2d Reconnaissance Battalion. As the Onslow Beach Area Commander, be prepared to provide one 20 man fire-fighting detail in accordance with the reference.






