



1. Relative to the scope of work to be performed as identified in the reference, the enclosure provides evidence of an unknown quantity of underground tanks which are no longer in service. Based upon knowledge and the recollection of activity personnel, evidence would indicate these tanks held the substances perchlorethylene and varsol. Highly recommend this area be considered for detailed investigation/evaluation within the upcoming "leaky underground storage tank (LUST) program."


