1. An investigation conducted pursuant to a recent pedestrian accident concluded that the street lighting along Curtis Road was inadequate and recommended that additional lighting be installed. Curtis Road actually has very little lighting and represents a continual safety hazard because of all the pedestrian traffic. In accordance with the reference, it is requested that a lighting survey be performed for Curtis Road from the intersection at Highway 17 through the Air Station to Marina Road as shown on the enclosure.

2. Upon completion of the survey, a scope drawing and cost estimate will be required in order that a project can be developed.
