
1. Reference (a) identifies by type, items which are included under the Marine Corps Historical Program. Paragraphs 4003.9 and 4015.1d designate a "historical holding" as an item not meeting the criteria for a historical or command museum, but which may be stored or displayed and focuses on the history of an organization and its mission. Marine Corps Engineer School presently has on display in front of its headquarters (Building BB-28) a Tractor, full-tracked, Model TD-18, the type of which is no longer in the active inventory (see Enclosure (1)).

2. Reference (b) revealed the intent of the Commanding General to assume overall responsibility for the numerous individual items of historical significance held by various units throughout the Base, and to in turn require the appropriate unit commander to assume responsibility for those items. The item included as enclosure (1) is nominated for inclusion in that program. The information provided as enclosure (2) is a result of a search by Base Plant Account of their records back to 1970 as well as Defense Property Disposal Office and MCES records.

3. This inoperable item is currently on static display on its own hardstand, and MCES will assume full responsibility for its care, cleaning, painting and any other required maintenance to ensure its appropriate representation as a historical item. 
Subj: Disposition of Tractors, TD-18, and Power Units, P-29

1. Reference (a) requested disposition of TD-18 tractors. Reference (b) approved the retention of eight (8) TD-18's for selective interchange of parts to maintain operating tractors for instruction until arrival of the new Euclid 82-30 tractor. Upon complete replacement of the TD-18 by the Euclid 82-30 the TD-18's could be dropped from the record and retained for demolition instruction. Reference (c) approved by reference (d) further requested the disposition of Power Control Units model P-29 with five units to be used for the same purpose as the TD-18's.

2. Reference (b) requires that the Commandant of the Marine Corps be advised by letter before the tractors are used for demolition instruction. Accordingly the Euclid 82-30 tractors have been received and the TD-18's and power units have been dropped from the records and are ready for demolition.

1. The request to retain quantity eight of the subject tractors, as listed in reference (a), for selective interchange of parts to maintain operating tractors for instruction until arrival of new Euclid 82-30 tractors is approved.

2. It is anticipated that the Advance Information Letter for the Euclid 82-30 will be published by 15 June 1970. At that time units will be authorized to commence requisitioning the Euclid 82-30 to satisfy requirements.

3. Upon complete replacement of the subject tractors by the Euclid 82-30's the TD-18's may be dropped from the records and retained for use by the Engineer School for demolition instruction. However, before the tractors are used in this capacity, the Commandant of the Marine Corps must be advised by letter.
