



1. As requested by the reference a EOD dud ordnance surface clearance sweep was conducted on 30 August 1984 in Compartment 36 as shown in enclosure (1) of the reference, which is inside of the N-1 Impact Area. Stand 26 was not swept because it lies outside of the N-1 Impact Area. No unexploded ordnance was located during this sweep. However, ordnance residue was located in Stands 13, 20, and 21 indicating that ordnance has been fired/dropped into the subject area. The ordnance residue was removed and destroyed on Range G-4A. There is a possibility of metal contamination in the subject timber.

2. Because of the dense growth it was not possible to conduct a thorough EOD dud ordnance surface clearance sweep of the subject area and additional dud ordnance or ordnance residue should be expected. A surface EOD sweep does not guarantee that there is no dud ordnance in the area cleared. However, it is this EOD Officer's opinion that it is safe to use heavy equipment to harvest timber. If desired a EOD technician will be provided for support in timber harvesting in the subject area.




COMPARTMENT 36 (Sheet #1)
