

1. In accordance with the reference, this command must establish a system for disposing of hazardous material containers, waste metals and wood.
2. Currently this command is supplied with three Dempsey Dumpsters, none of which are marked specifically for metal or wood disposal. In view of the command's current problem with waste disposal and the Dempsey Dumpsters already being utilized by this command at this time. It is requested that each dumpster be designated for a different waste item, (i.e. one dumpster marked trash/paper, one marked wood only, and one marked metal only).
3. In addition, it is requested that corresponding pick-ups be established for each dumpster on a weekly basis, and that one additional dumpster be provided to this command for trash/paper.
