



1. The subject request to upgrade the Marine Corps Air Station (Helicopter), New River Marines' swimming area has been reviewed for consistency with requirements of reference (a). As a result of an on-site review of the proposed work, reference (b), the US Army Corps of Engineers representative has advised that the proposal to place sand on the shoreline does not require a permit, if the following requirements are complied with:

- a. Fill (i.e. sand) will not be placed below high water line.
- b. Fill (i.e. sand) will not be placed on marsh grass.

2. The subject request is approved with the condition that prior to removal of any sand from Onslow Beach, that an on-site review of the proposed work be held involving personnel responsible for accomplishing the work and a representative of Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs Division to insure a clear understanding of requirements listed in paragraphs 1a and 1b above.
