Atlantic Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command (LANTDIV) has completed its review of the Initial Release, Public Health Assessment for MCB Camp Lejeune. It is apparent that the report was prepared without the benefit of access to several significant documents that are part of the Camp Lejeune administrative record for the Installation Restoration (IR) program. We feel that inclusion of this information is essential to accurately discuss potential health hazards at Camp Lejeune. We would like to offer you whatever assistance you require in obtaining the most complete and up-to-date information possible for inclusion in this report.

A letter to Ms. Carol Aloisio of ATSDR from Mr. Robert Warren of MCB Camp Lejeune of October 17, 1994 supplies a complete index of the administrative record. It is our hope that you will review this list and identify the documents that you have not had the opportunity to include in the preparation of your report. Complete copies of the documents that are missing from your collection will be supplied to you as soon as possible.

In addition, Camp Lejeune has indicated that you have been added to the Technical Review Committee (TRC) for the IR program. Membership in the TRC will ensure that ATSDR will (1) be notified of all documents published (and available for review and comment upon request), (2) receive complete copies of all Draft Final documents for review and comment, and (3) be invited to actively participate in TRC meetings.
