1. A Public Health Assessment for Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune was performed by the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry. It identified groundwater contamination as a potential health hazard. In response to this assessment, an annual program to monitor these active supply wells was enacted.
2. Enclosed is a copy of the first annual test results of the program prepared by Bionomics Laboratory Inc. These results indicate four wells with constituents above the North Carolina Administrative Code, Title 15A, Chapter 2, Subchapter 2L standards. As discussed during the reference, well 603 has been taken offline and all four wells will be resampled to validate the results before additional actions are taken. Additional actions will be coordinated with Mr. Baker.
