Neal:

On 5 October 1998, Major Jensen received a call from a civilian attorney, Mr. Rich Cone, esq. (Mr. Cone's phone number is (704) 342-5303) Mr. Cone told Major Jensen that he (Mr. Cone) represents ABC 1-Hour Dry Cleaners in PRP negotiations with the US EPA regarding remediation of PCE groundwater contamination at or near Tarawa Terrace and the City of Jacksonville, NC.

Mr. Cone revealed that the U.S. EPA's "documentation" revealed a strange pattern of PCE groundwater contamination with a concentration of PCE contaminants suggesting more than one contamination plume. Mr. Cone also revealed that he has personally observed a "pump and treat" groundwater remediation site at an "auto hobby shop" within Tarawa Terrace. (Mr. Cone apparently believes the USMC released PCE to groundwater from this "auto hobby shop" site and the Marine Corps might also be a PRP to PCE contamination near Tarawa Terrace.)

So, you or your staff could receive a call or other request for information from this civilian attorney. And, if he calls or otherwise requests any information from you or your staff, please refer him or his request to me. I will coordinate all FOIA releases of information in this matter with NAVFAC and Camp Lejeune.
