Dear Mr. McAleney:

This letter is in response to your letter of 22 August 2001 to the Assistant Chief of Staff, Installations and Environment.

In your letter, you requested information pertinent to the Camp Lejeune Water Survey. In an effort to expedite your response, we have limited our search to documents dated prior to 1990. If you have need for documents dated after 1990, we ask that you request the specific documents desired under a separate Freedom of Information Act Request. In response to your request, the following information is provided:

1. Installation Restoration (IR) Site 69, the Rifle Range Chemical Dump:

Request A: What chemicals were or are in the drums that are buried? After years of being there, what has happened to them due to natural corrosion of these drums? What other chemicals were deposited in this site? What is being done to the chemicals that have leached into the aquifer?

*Response: For information regarding investigative activities carried out at Installation Restoration Site 69, please be advised that all pertinent documents are publicly available within the MCB, Camp Lejeune IR Program Administrative Record. The Administrative Record can be accessed on the internet at the following website: <http://www.bakerenv.com/camplejeune/>. If you are unable to access this information or if any specific documents related to IR Site 69 are not available at the foregoing website, these items may be requested directly from Camp Lejeune.*

Request B: What water distribution system distributed water to the Rifle Range or was it included in the base wide system?

Response: The Rifle Range water distribution system provided potable water to the Rifle Range area until a contract was established with Onslow County in 1994 to provide potable water to this area.

Request C: How much of Site 69 contaminated the wells at the Rifle Range?

Response: Enclosures 1-19 may pertain. Further information regarding investigative activities at IR Site 69 may be found within the administrative record located at the website provided above.

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2. French Creek Barracks Area:

Request A: Any and all updated reports on this specific area called French Creek. Especially, those that have to do with the distribution of water in this region.

Request B: All updated reports on the contaminated wells in this region.

Response: MCB, Camp Lejeune possesses no documents specifically responsive to water distribution or well contamination in the French Creek area. However, documents pertaining to the Hadnot Point water distribution system (which serves the French Creek area) and the contaminated wells within this system are provided as enclosures 20-39.

3. Map of Camp Lejeune illustrating Operable Units, IR Sites, and Contaminated Wells.

Response: A map of Camp Lejeune illustrating Operable Units and IR Sites may be found within the administrative record located at the website provided above. However, as a result of recent terrorist activities, increased security measures are in place at MCB, Camp Lejeune. Consequently, maps illustrating water supply wells, active or inactive, are considered sensitive information and cannot be released under the FOIA. See 5 U.S.C. §552 (b)(9).

I hope that the enclosed documents satisfy your request. Because your request has been denied in part, you are advised of your right to appeal this determination, in writing to the following address:

Your appeal must be postmarked within 60 calendar days from the date of this letter to be considered. A statement as to why your appeal should be granted should be included and the enclosed copy of this letter should be attached. Both the appeal letter and the envelope should bear the notation, "Freedom of Information Act Appeal." The fees associated with the processing of your request are waived.
