This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of March 15, 2003, in which you seek agency records in reference to the drinking water by Avolis Engineering, P.A., and Baker Environmental, Incorporated. Your request was received by this office on March 18, 2003 and assigned file number 346-03.

Following an extensive manual and electronic search of available documents in support of these requests, responsive information is provided below:

Request 1: Avolis Engineering Report "Drinking Water Distribution System Inventory and Sampling Study, Marine Corps Base (MCB), Camp Lejeune," July 28, 1993 (Draft).

Response: Text and Appendices A, B, C and D of Avolis Engineering Final Report, "Drinking Water System Inventory and Sampling Study, MCB, Camp Lejeune," November 2, 1995 are enclosed on the compact disk.
