Dear Chairman Durbin and Ranking Member Grassley:

We write in support of the nomination of Candace Jackson-Akiwumi to serve as a judge on the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit. We urge the Committee and full Senate to promptly review and confirm her nomination.

We are a cross-section of former prosecutors, private practitioners, corporate in-house counsel, and legal advocates who are representative of the broad diversity of the bar that practices in the Northern District of Illinois. Many of us have spent our entire careers practicing in the Northern District, have served in leadership roles in the public and private sectors, and we are all deeply committed to our judicial system and the fair administration of justice, which is the bedrock of our democracy.

The district, which includes Chicago and the surrounding 18 counties in Illinois, is a microcosm of our country, including rural areas and the third largest city in the nation; a racially and ethnically diverse populace; large corporate headquarters as well as some of the most economically challenged neighborhoods in the United States. The Northern District of Illinois bar is a community itself, with a strong tradition of collegiality and mutual respect amongst adversaries. The cases litigated in the federal courts in the Seventh Circuit, which, of course, includes Illinois, Indiana and Wisconsin, address a wide range of civil and criminal matters, and raise some of the most consequential legal issues of the day. As a result, the court has long been seen as a leader in American jurisprudence, and we are all proud of what small role those of us on this letter have been able to play in the work of the court.

A great strength of our nation and of our governmental institutions is that we are a representative government, representing the entirety of our nation. A circuit court that reflects the full diversity of the Seventh Circuit will only strengthen the court, its decisions and the administration of justice. It is with these crucial considerations in mind that we join together in support of the nomination of Candace Jackson-Akiwumi to the Circuit Court.

If confirmed, Ms. Jackson-Akiwumi would be the first federal defender ever seated on the court. Many of us on this letter are former prosecutors, as well as criminal defense lawyers, and we all agree that having a judge with this experience on the court would be an important addition. If confirmed, she will be the only judge of color on the court, and first to join since Judge Ann Claire Williams retired from the court in 2017. Again, this diversity of experience is critically important to reflect on the bench. And although we do not know Ms. Jackson-Akiwumi personally, her record and career reflect the commitment to the law and range of legal experience that will serve her well on the court.

Thank you for your consideration of this letter. We hope that the Committee and the Senate will consider the nomination of Candace Jackson-Akiwumi promptly, and confirm her to the Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit.
