I am writing to express my support and urge the confirmation of the Honorable Judge Robert Kirsch as a Federal Judge for the New Jersey District. It has been my blessing and joy to know Judge Kirsch for the last ten years. We were introduced to each other by a mutual friend, who happened to be a prominent criminal defense lawyer in New Jersey. We have gone on to become very close friends. I was assigned by the General Conference of the AME Church to South Africa in 2012 and to Georgia in 2016, and our friendship has only become closer. He has a lovely wife and is the father of two children.

Judge Kirsch has served on the Superior Court of New Jersey for thirteen years in all three court divisions, Family, Civil and Criminal. He has proven himself to be a remarkable judge.
