We are current and former prosecutors from jurisdictions across the country. We write in our personal capacities to you and members of the Senate Judiciary Committee in support of the nomination of Ms. Choudhury to serve as a District Judge on the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York ("EDNY").

District Courts play a critical role in our criminal justice system. Based on our experience, we understand how critical it is that district judges possess the impartiality, judgment, integrity, and intellect necessary to serve in that role. We are aware that Ms. Choudhury has been accused of making factually inaccurate statements about policing in America.
