I write in response to requests submitted through the Committee for waiver of applicable limitations on the public release of four documents from Judge Brett M. Kavanaugh's service in the White House Counsel's Office that our review team initially produced on a "Committee Confidential" basis. On behalf of President George W. Bush, we have no objection to the public release of the documents identified by the Committee. The White House has authorized me to inform you that the President of the United States also has no objection to their public release. We will produce versions of the four documents with the "Committee Confidential" stamp removed shortly.

In addition, we understand that a Member of the Committee has requested that the following documents be publicly produced: REV\_00339799, REV\_00339902, REV\_00343077, REV\_00343221, and REV\_00340472. These documents have previously been publicly produced and therefore have not been included in this production.
