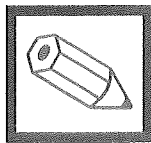

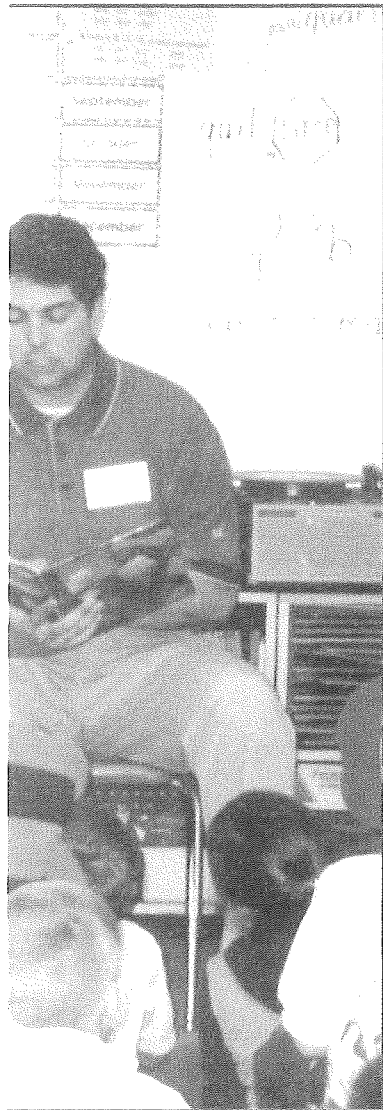

3. Tougher penalties for crimes committed in a school zone



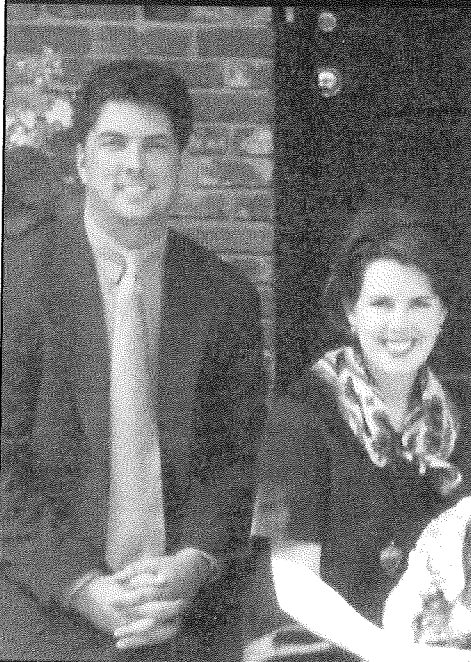

Boggs launches bid for Superior Court judge

State Rep. Mike Boggs officially qualified this week as a candidate for Superior Court judge in the Waycross Judicial Circuit, seeking the post held by Judge _____ Blount, who is retiring.

“In my ____ years of legal practice, I have gained the trial experience necessary to serve as a Superior Court judge,” Boggs said. “Having served in the Georgia House of Representatives on the Judiciary Committee and as vice chairman of the Public Safety Committee has given me further insight into the issues facing our court system today.”

Boggs, 41, has resided most of his life in the Waycross Circuit, which includes Bacon, Brantley, Charlton, Coffee, Pierce and Ware counties. A graduate of Waycross High School and Georgia Southern University, he earned his law degree from the Walter F. George School of Law at Mercer University.

During his two terms in the Georgia House, Boggs sponsored several pieces of successful legislation dealing with public safety and judicial issues. He passed the Child Protection Act, strengthening state laws protecting children from sexual exploitation and Internet pornography. Boggs also worked with the Georgia Bureau of Investigation and Georgia Sheriff's Association to pass stronger laws related to the sexual offender registry, the seizure of property from drug dealers and criminal background checks for bail bondsmen.

As a state representative, Boggs has also been successful in securing funding for the new public health laboratory in Waycross, completion of the Ga. 84 and U.S. 1 widening projects, expanded facilities at Okefenokee Technical College and many other local programs that require state resources.

He was named as Georgia's Freshman Legislator of the Year for the 2001-02 session and was recognized by Georgia Trend magazine's "40 under 40" list of top young leaders in the state. He is a recipient of the Kiwanis Club of Waycross James Harley Award and the Waycross YMCA Community Service Award. He is married to the former Heather Haynes of Waycross.

“It has been an honor and privilege to serve in the state legislature these past four years,” Boggs said. “I am asking the voters to allow me to continue to serve the public, but now in the judicial branch of government. I pledge to be a judge who demonstrates fairness to all parties who come before the court.”

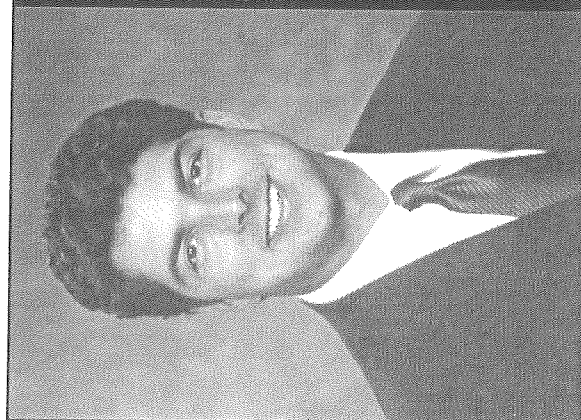
The non-partisan judicial primary will be held July 20.
