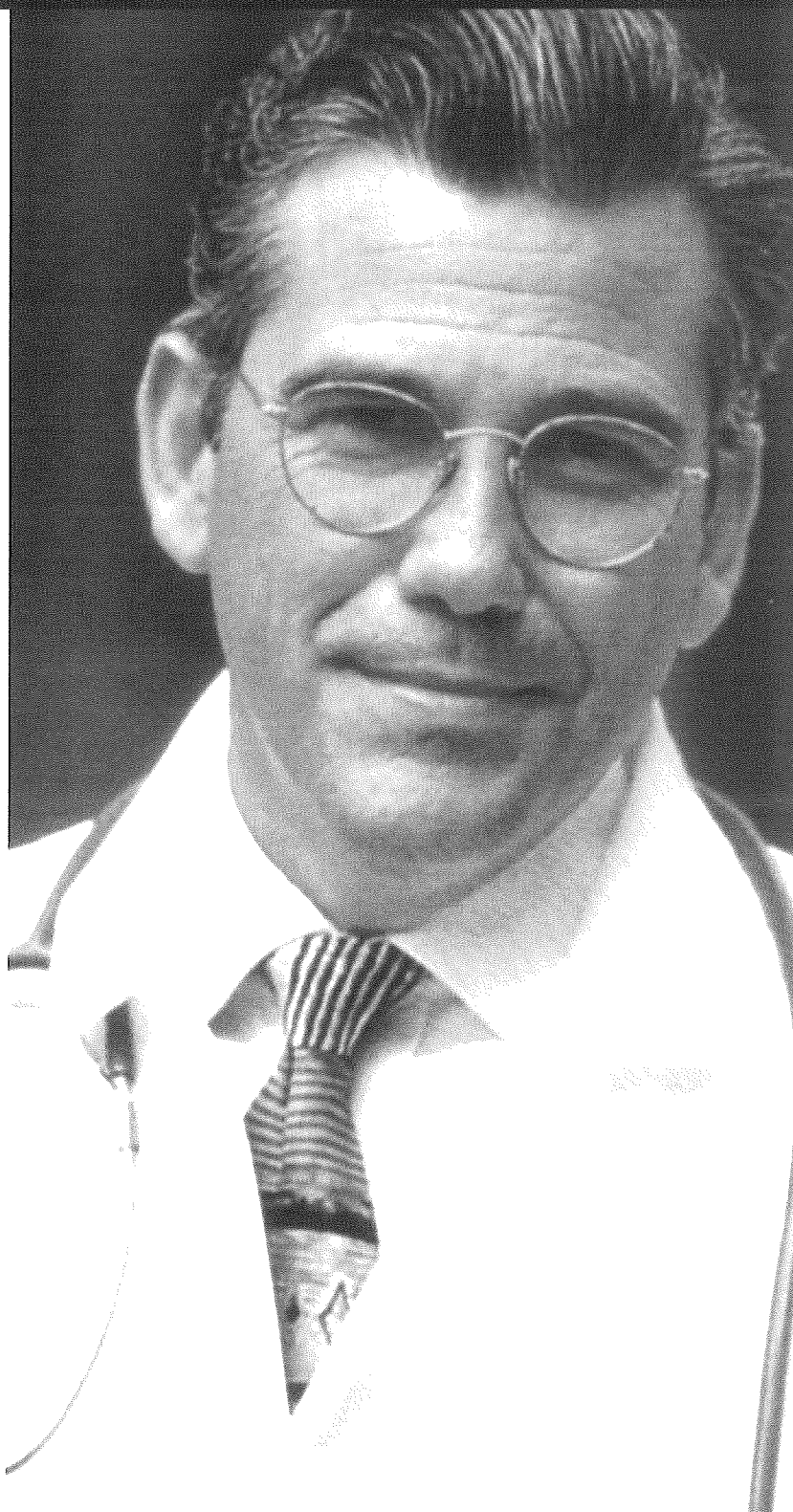

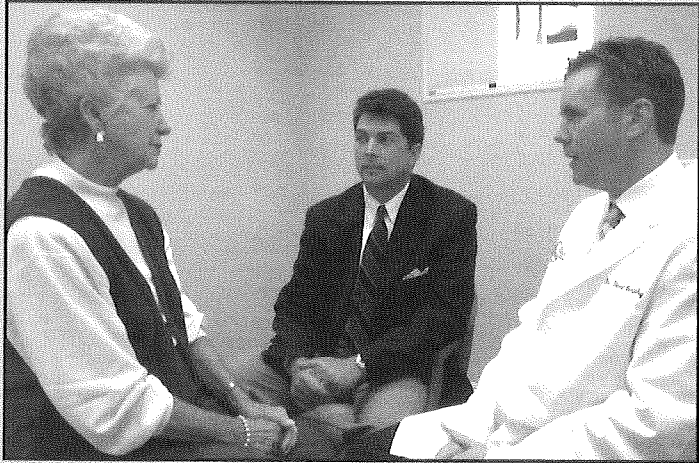

Prescription Drugs at Lower Prices

The cost of prescription drugs is out of control. Often families are forced to choose between paying for the essentials and paying for the medicine their doctor prescribes. Lowering the cost of prescription drugs should be a top priority.

Under my plan any family in the state will be able to purchase a GeorgiaCare card for \$5, which allows them to purchase prescription drugs at the same low prices government insurance programs pay. For as little as \$5, lower prescription drugs can become a reality.

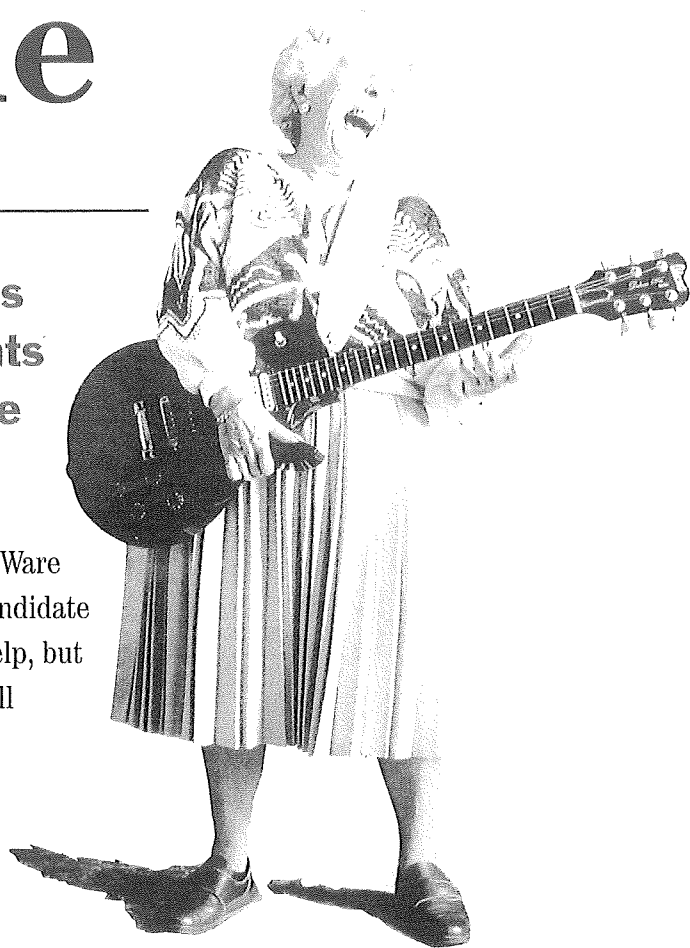
Putting Medical Decisions Back in the Hands of Patients and Doctors -- Not Insurance Company Bureaucrats

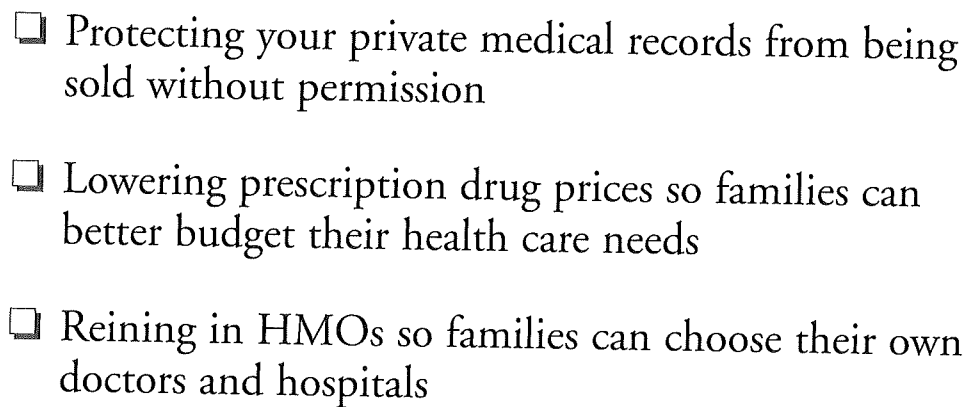

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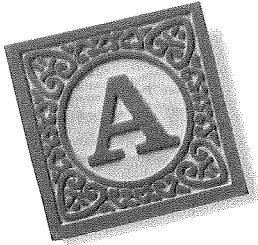

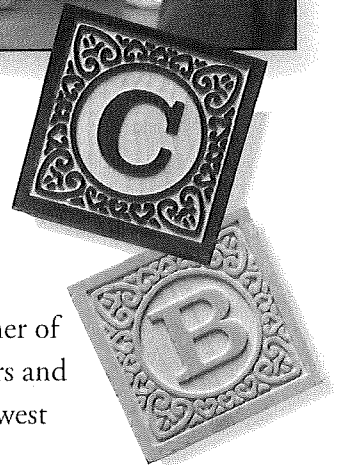

Mike Boggs Will Vote to Make it Easier for Teachers to Remove Disruptive Students From the Classroom

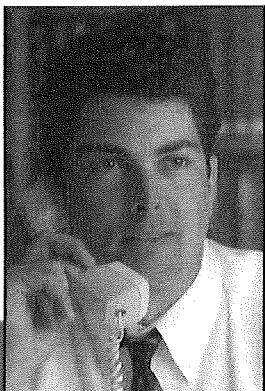
