RE: Nomination of Daniel E. Burrows for Assistant Attorney General for the Office of Legal Policy

Dear Chairman Grassley & Ranking Member Durbin:

Dan Burrows is an outstanding choice to serve as the Department of Justice's next Assistant Attorney General for the Office of Legal Policy. We, the undersigned Attorneys General, strongly support his nomination, and we encourage you to move swiftly to confirm him.

Mr. Burrows has an extensive and distinguished record of public service. Nearly his entire career has been dedicated to government or non-profit work and, on top of that, he has served honorably in the Army Reserve for more than fourteen years. Furthermore, the breadth of his experience would be hard to match, having litigated a host of both civil and criminal cases, and managed attorneys in the Kansas Attorney General's Office who dealt with an abundance of different legal issues facing the state. Given the Office of Legal Policy's broad portfolio, Mr. Burrows' similarly broad experience would greatly benefit the Department of Justice and the American people.

In addition to reciting his many accomplishments, we write to give you something that merely reviewing a list of job titles and responsibilities can't—namely, an attestation that Mr. Burrows' integrity, trustworthiness, diligence, and character are all of exceptional quality, and precisely what the Senate should prize in the President's nominees.

The Attorney General community is close, and we work with other offices frequently. As the Chief Deputy Attorney General of Kansas, Mr. Burrows was friendly, well liked, honest, and dependable. Likewise, he was forceful but thoughtful both in his pursuit of Kansas' legal positions and his vigilant defense of the Constitution and the rule of law.

We have seen Mr. Burrows display the superb judgment, commitment to the public, and dedication to his fellow Americans necessary to serve as an Assistant Attorney General in the Department of Justice. His experience is especially well-suited to head up Attorney General Bondi's Office of Legal Policy. We therefore urge this committee to positively report Mr. Burrows' nomination and confirmation.
