9 (2) FUNDING.—There are authorized to be ap-  
10 propriated, from the amounts made available under  
11 section 6(a)(3)(A)(i), such sums as may be nec-  
12 essary to carry out this subsection.

13 (c) INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS.—

14 (1) BORDER PATROL STATIONS.—The Secretary  
15 shall—

16 (A) construct additional Border Patrol sta-  
17 tions in the Southwest border region that U.S.  
18 Border Patrol determines are needed to provide  
19 full operational support in rural, high-trafficked  
20 areas; and

21 (B) analyze the feasibility of creating addi-  
22 tional Border Patrol sectors along the Southern  
23 border to interrupt drug trafficking operations.
