4 (d) PRECLUSION OF SOCIAL SECURITY CREDITS FOR
5 PERIODS WITHOUT WORK AUTHORIZATION.—

6 (1) INSURED STATUS.—Section 214 of the So-
7 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 414) is amended by
8 adding at the end the following new subsection:

9 “(d) INSURED STATUS.—

10 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to paragraphs (2)
11 and (3), for purposes of subsections (a) and (b), no
12 quarter of coverage shall be credited for any cal-
13 endar year—

14 “(A) beginning after December 31, 2003,
15 and before January 1, 2014, with respect to an
16 individual who has been granted registered pro-
17 visional immigrant status pursuant to section
18 245B of the Immigration and Nationality Act;

19 or *beginning after December 31, 2003,*
and before January 1, 2014,

20 “(B) in which an individual earned such
21 quarter of coverage while present under an ex-
22 pired nonimmigrant visa,

23 unless the Commissioner of Social Security deter-
24 mines, on the basis of information provided to the
25 Commissioner by the individual, that the individual
