Mr. Evans currently serves as the Deputy Assistant Attorney General for Intelligence, the career official who supervises all aspects of the Department of Justice's implementation and oversight of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 (FISA). He previously served over the last 12 years in a number of career positions within the Department of Justice's National Security Division, including as both Chief and Deputy Chief of the Office of Intelligence's Counterterrorism Unit.
