3 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This section may be cited as the
4 "Tibetan Refugee Assistance Act of 2013".

5 (b) TRANSITION FOR DISPLACED TIBETANS.—Not6 withstanding the numerical limitations specified in sec7 tions 201 and 202 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
8 (8 U.S.C. 1151 and 1152), 5,000 immigrant visas shall
9 be made available to qualified displaced Tibetans described
10 in subsection (c) during the 3-year period beginning on
11 October 1, 2013.

12 (c) QUALIFIED DISPLACED TIBETAN DESCRIBED.—

1	(1) IN GENERAL.—An individual is a qualified
2	displaced Tibetan if such individual—
3	(A) is a native of Tibet; and
4	(B) has been continuously residing in India

8	poses of paragraph (1)(A), an individual shall be

10	(A) was born in Tibet; or
11	(B) is the son, daughter, grandson, or

under subsection (b) are made available to qualified dis placed Tibetans described in subsection (c) or (d) in an
 equitable manner, giving preference to those qualified dis placed Tibetans who—

- 5 (1) are not resettled in India or Nepal; or
- 6 (2) are most likely to be resettled successfully7 in the United States.
