3 **SEC. 3611. PILOT PROGRAM TO DETER, DETECT, AND PRE-**
4 **VENT CHILD TRAFFICKING.**

5 (a) IMPLEMENTATION.—Not later than 120 days
6 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary,
7 pursuant to section 235(a)(4) of the William Wilberforce
8 Trafficking Victims Protection Reauthorization Act of
9 2008 (8 U.S.C. 1232(a)(4)), shall establish and begin im-
10 plementing a pilot program to utilize the services of inde-
11 pendent child welfare professionals with expertise in cul-
12 turally competent, trauma-centered, and developmentally

1 appropriate interviewing skills to assist U.S. Customs and
2 Border Protection in the screening of children attempting
3 to enter the United States.

4 (b) MINIMUM PORTS OF ENTRY.—The Secretary
5 shall ensure that the pilot program established under sub-
6 section (a) is implemented at not fewer than 6 ports of
7 entry, including not fewer than 3 ports of entry at which
8 the U.S. Customs and Border Protection station assigned
9 to that port has had in its custody during the preceding
10 2 fiscal years a yearly average of 50 or more unaccom-
11 panied alien children.

12 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 15 months after the im-
13 plementation of the pilot program under this section, the
14 Secretary shall submit a report to the Committee on the
15 Judiciary of the Senate and the Committee on the Judici-
16 ary of the House of Representatives that—

17 (1) describes the operation of the pilot program;

18 and

19 (2) includes recommendations on whether the
20 pilot program should be expanded beyond the ports
21 of entry in which it was first implemented.

22 **SEC. 3612. RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.**

23 Nothing in this subtitle may be construed to preempt
