AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. FRANKEN

Viz:

1       At the end of subtitle C of title III, add the following:

2   **SEC. 3507. TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR TRAF-**  
3                   **FICKING PROTECTIONS.**

4       (a) TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITY.—

5           (1) IN GENERAL.—All unexpended balances ap-  
6       propriated or otherwise available to the Department  
7       of Health and Human Services and its Office of Ref-  
8       ugee Resettlement in connection with the functions  
9       provided for in paragraphs (5) and (6) of section  
10      235(c) of the William Wilberforce Trafficking Vic-  
11      tims Protection Reauthorization Act of 2008 (8  
12      U.S.C. 1232(c)), shall, subject to section 202 of the

1        Budget and Accounting Procedures Act of 1950, be  
2        transferred to the Department of Justice. Funds  
3        transferred pursuant to this paragraph shall remain  
4        available until expended and shall be used only for  
5        the purposes for which the funds were originally au-  
6        thorized and appropriated.

7            (2) CONTRACT AUTHORITY.—The Attorney  
8        General may award grants to, and enter into con-  
9        tracts to carry out the functions set forth in para-  
10       graphs (5) and (6) of Section 235(c) of the William  
11       Wilberforce Trafficking Victims Protection Reau-  
12       thorization Act of 2008.

13       (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section 235(c) of  
14       the William Wilberforce Trafficking Victims Protection  
15       Reauthorization Act of 2008 is amended as follows:

16            (1) In paragraph (5)—

17                    (A) by striking “Secretary of Health and  
18                    Human Services” each place it appears and in-  
19                    serting “Attorney General”; and

20                    (B) by striking the last sentence.

21            (2) In paragraph (6)—

22                    (A) by striking “Secretary of Health and  
23                    Human Services” each place it appears and in-  
24                    serting “Attorney General”:

1                   (B) by striking “Secretary” each place it  
2                   appears in subparagraphs (B)(ii), (D), and (F)  
3                   and inserting “Attorney General”; and  
4                   (C) by striking “and Human Services” in  
5                   subparagraph (F).
