I am sure you are awash in letters supporting the nomination of Debo Adegbile for Assistant Attorney General for Civil Rights. He is an experienced, thoughtful and in every way able candidate for the post.

Nonetheless I wanted to add the perspective of one who once held the position for which Mr. Adegbile has been nominated, having also worked at the NAACP Legal Defense Fund. advocate would, if ever in conflict, have to yield to the role of an AAG as an enforcer of the law. For example, the Congress reinstituted the federal death penalty while I was AAG; and while I had worked in opposition to the death penalty at LDF, I understood that my role in the Justice Department, and my oath, required me to enforce the law. I am confident Mr. Adegbile can and will approach the position with that same respect for duty.

Mr. Adegbile will make a fine AAG. I hope you will give him your favorable and prompt consideration.
